IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following schedule will govern all further proceedings in this case:

(1) Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment shall be filed no later than May 31, 2011, and the brief shall be limited to 6500 words, excluding caption and

certificates of service and compliance.


(2) Federal Defendants' Cross Motion/Opposition for Summary Judgment shall be filed no later than June 14, 2011, and the brief shall be limited to 6500 words, excluding caption and certificates of service and compliance.

(3) Plaintiff's Opposition/Response brief shall be filed no later than June 21, 2011, and the brief shall be limited to 3250 words, excluding caption and certificates of service and compliance.

(4) Federal Defendants' Reply brief shall be filed no later than June 28, 2011, and the brief shall be limited to 3250 words, excluding caption and certificates of service and compliance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in documents filed with the Court, the parties shall use only commonly understood acronyms, such as NEPA, NFMA, ESA, and EIS.
